- A. SIR Project 2016 to increase SIR membership
 - 1. What does the membership want?
 - 2. What works and what doesn't work?
 - Came up with a plan of action!
- B. New mission statement "We are SIR Make Friends for Life"
 - 1. De-emphasizing "Retirement"
 - 2. "SIR" implies a courteous greeting for people we respect
 - 3. Emphasizing making "male friends" for life
 - 4. Looking for members who have "discretionary time"
- C. New recommended behaviors
 - 1. Improve orientation for new members
 - a. Should be an orientation program for new members
 - i. Members mentor new members
 - ii. Stress the forming of male friends
 - iii. Let them know this is a volunteer organization
 - iv. An opportunity to enjoy yourself while serving others
 - b. Need follow-up of new members to see if needs are being met
 - 2. Improve member retention
 - a. Call members who don't come to lunch to see if their needs are being met
 - i. Does member need help to get to the luncheon?
 - ii. Is member injured or unwell?
 - iii. Does member need help caring for a spouse?
 - b. Are there presentations you would prefer to see?
 - c. Use surveys at meetings to assess the menu, the venue, and the speaker
 - 3. Improve leadership of the organization
 - a. Set the tone with new members that leadership is expected in time
 - b. Set up backups for every leadership position; so succession is planned for
 - c. Provide coaching and training for new members regarding leadership positions
 - d. Personally invite members to take on positions of leadership
 - e. Provide help for Little SIRs in setting up speakers
 - set up several regional speaker's bureau
 - ii. set up a speakers' committee at each Chapter to assist the Little SIR
 - 4. Improve name recognition for SIR State, Governors and Managers, IT
 - a. New video and marketing materials are being planned for
 - b. provide templates for succession planning, publicity, etc.
 - c. Improve training at all levels

- 5. Reduce administrative requirements
 - a. Minimize the SIR rules
 - b. Reduce reporting requirements to the minimum needed
 - c. Invest in technology to improve communications and reduce meeting costs
- 6. Improve recruitment activities

 - b. Present SIR information at various venues that reflect Chapter activities
 - i. Golf Pro Shops
 - ii. Motor home shows
 - iii. Fishing shows
 - iv. Bowling alleys
 - c. Chapters get together to sponsor a booth at certain venues
 - d. Develop activities to include spouses
